All entrants to the Fairest of the Fair must be actual residents and domiciled in White County, Tennessee, or be a student in White County Schools. Actual resident is defined as an individual living on property assessed to White County by the White County Tax Assessor's Office. Notwithstanding the foregoing, applicants temporarily attending college or vocational school with the intent to return to their home in White County are considered residents of the county for purposes of this contest. In cases of joint custody one parent/guardian must be a White County resident, and the contestant must attend a White County School in order to qualify for pageant entry.

This contest is co-sponsored by the White County Fair Association and the Tennessee Association of Fairs. A state-wide contest will be held in Murfreesboro in conjunction with the annual meeting of the Association in January 2022.

Rules:

- 2. A contestant cannot qualify if she has ever been married, had a child, or been found guilty of a felony.

- 9. Winner is required to be present for other Fair Events throughout the week, when requested.
- 10. Any criminal history will be grounds for disqualification.
- 11. Disrespectful comments on social media of any kind regarding this event or a contestant will be grounds for disqualification.
- 12. Reigning winners **CANNOT** compete is another fair pageant the same year they are crowning a new winner.
